### **Neo-Natal Baby Blankets**

We are hoping to replicate, and possibly beat, last years' efforts, which saw our Friday plus group knit squares that ultimately made up 6 baby blankets, which were then donated to Basildon's Neo-Natal Unit. We would be very appreciative of any help in reaching their target of 10, or more, blankets this year. Please see Sally-Ann or Anne for more details.

The basic pattern is :

Double knit wool - primary colours

Size 8 needles

Plain stitch, single coloured strips measuring 5 inches by 25 inches.

Each blanket will consist of 7 brightly coloured stripes.

### **Shoebboxes for the homeless**

Friday Club and Friday Club + are collecting shoe boxes with Christmas contents to give to the homeless in our local area and would be pleased if our congregation could join in too.

The shoe boxes would need to be wrapped so that the lid can open and filled with a varied assortment of treats.

Suggested items could be:
